To provide a safe space to engage in activities such as basketball, parachute work, skittles, skipping, bowls or Kwik Cricket etc.</p> <p>Early Years to develop gross motor skills as part of their curriculum. Supervisors can support children in developing their skills and a love of sport to increase children's confidence and participation in a wider range of sports activities and clubs.</p> <p>New resources to replace old stock in poor condition: additional resources will be purchased to help deliver the requirements of the National Curriculum PE and games and outdoor equipment.</p> <p>New resources and improved access will help with the organisation of lessons and delivery of our annual Sports Days which include whole school.</p> <p>Children have an opportunity to use skills taught in PE during lunchtimes.</p>
