### *To Reserve:*

Adults:	80p per reserved item
Children:	Free

### *Fines:*

Fines are charged for each overdue book at the following rate:

Adults (18+)	17p per book per day overdue
Children	No charge

Fines are not charged for those days when the library is closed.

Overdue media:

Audio items/DVDs - Repeat hire charge for each additional hire period or part of a hire period.
